



## YOUTH AMBASSADOR PROFILE

**Purpose:** To serve as a local volunteer of the Home School Foundation (HSF) Ambassador Program alongside a parent or guardian who is an ambassador

**Key Responsibilities:**

- » Serve until the completion of the ambassador project to which you commit
- » Informally represent HSF at local homeschool events, church meetings, civic gatherings, or other events
- » Promote the State Ambassador Fund
- » Seek out fellow Youth Ambassadors and their parents or guardians to serve on the ambassador team
- » Create and implement ambassador projects
- » Secure the co-signature of an adult ambassador for projects

**Qualifications:**

- » A heart for God and a compassion for the needy
- » Willingness to serve until completion of ambassador project
- » Ability to receive direction and work as a team
- » Commitment to the principles of HSF

**Support Provided:**

- » Guidance from State and Community Ambassadors
- » Partnership with parent/guardian ambassador
- » Resources in HSF website
- » Regular Ambassador Conference Calls
- » Documentation of service from HSF for resume

**Requirements:**

- » Be 15 to 18 years of age.
- » Be sponsored by a parent or guardian who is an enrolled ambassador
- » Complete Youth Ambassador Application and provide 2 references
- » Commit to serve for the duration of the ambassador project
